# **INTRODUCTION TO LARGE-SCALE ASSESSMENTS OF LEARNING** 23 – 26 September 2014, Bangkok, Thailand

To support countries of the Asia-Pacific region in strengthening their capacity in the area of assessment or monitoring quality of learning, UNESCO Bangkok (NEQMAP Secretariat), with generous support from the Global Partnership for Education (GPE) and Malaysian Funds-in-Trust (M-FIT), is organizing a four-day workshop from 23 to 26 September 2014 in Bangkok, Thailand.

The workshop aims to present an overview of large-scale learning assessments by introducing selected, well-known models and practices at national, regional and international levels, while focusing on the practical parameters of each model's implementation (e.g. what, why, who, when, where and how). The workshop will emphasize the use of assessment in particular.

The main target audience shall be government officials with responsibility for conducting large-scale assessments in their respective countries of the Asia-Pacific region, while also welcoming participants from other organizations who are interested in the workshop.

#### Venue and Date:

The four-day workshop will be held at the **Bangkok Marriott Hotel Sukhumvit** in Bangkok, Thailand. The course will commence on Tuesday 23 September 2014 and conclude on Friday 26 September 2014. Participants are expected to stay for the full duration of the course and attend all sessions.
