# Assessment System of School Education in Nepal

## Education System:

- Continuous Assessment System (Grade 1-3)
- CAS+ SBA (Grade 4-7)
- SBA (Grade 9&11)
- Public Exam Grade 8 (Local Government)
- Public Exam Grade 10 (Province Government but not practiced yet)
- Public Exam Grade 12 (Federal Government/NEB)
- National Achievement of Student Assessment (Education Review Office)

# Practices of CA in Nepali School

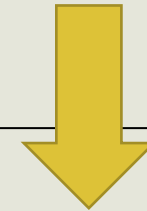
- Policies are strong (CDC, 2076) for classroom assessment but the practice is weak (CDC, 2076, MOEST, 2078).
- Students are not getting feedback properly (MOEST, 2078):  
Feedback is important in CA.
- Student teacher ratio, teacher capability and classroom environment
- Social-cultural factors (Mans, 2019)
- The teaching-learning activity is focusing on teach to test.

# COVID context: Shifting Public Exam to Classroom Assessment

- Validity questions were arise in Covid pandemic.
- Sufficient learning data was not available in the school.
- Classroom assessment practice and record keeping system found weak.
- Testing culture influence the assessment system



- Effective implementation of classroom assessment can measure student learning precisely.
- Variety of assessment strategies can be used by the teacher.
- Systematic record keeping system will support to create learning data with evidence.



**Classroom Assessment can Measures Student Learning Better than PE.**

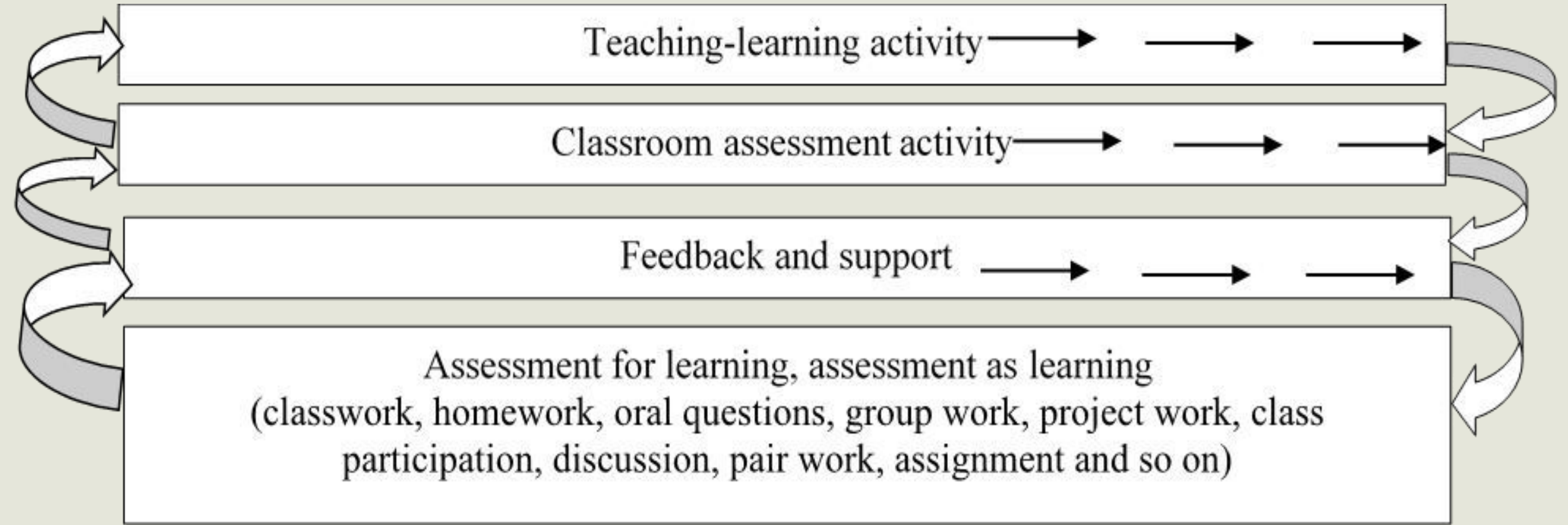
# Classroom Assessment to Enhance & Recover Learning

- Greater autonomy to teacher
- Multiple approaches
- Timely feedback & individual support
- Diagnose the learning difficulty
- Informal approach
- Multiple times (minute by minute)
- Flexible instructional plan
- Learning difficulty identification
- Motivation to learn (no stress and test anxiety)

# Challenges to implement CA in School

- Teacher Capability
  - Teacher mentoring program is not sufficient.
- Testing Culture
  - School autonomy for selecting the assessment strategies has not established.
- Student Teacher Ratio in classroom
  - Conducive learning environment
- CA has not been used for the purpose of AfL.
- CA can not be effective if student responsibility is not activate.
- Authentic assessment has not been practiced adequately.

## Strategies to Enhance CA in School

- Teacher capacity development (training/workshop/mentorship)
- Strong monitoring and support mechanism should be established at local and school level.
- Activating the student responsibility to learning practice should increased.
- Authentic assessment practice should be emphasized.
- Learning diagnostic tools
- Teacher autonomy to select the assessment strategy.
- Policy implementation and advocacy should be in place.
- To assess social emotional skills and other non-cognitive skills

# Recovery Approach

- Rapid Classroom Assessment
- Sharing the minimum learning objectives and learning milestone
- Promptly feedback
- Learning progression record tracking
- Struggling content areas should be identified and give more focus
- Teaching Learning (TL) and Assessment should be integrating in the pedagogy.
- Multiple assessment strategies can be incorporated.



# Conclusion

- CA effectiveness depends upon teacher autonomy and competencies.
- CA has a greater flexibility in classroom to assess student learning progression.
- CA provides timely feedback and support to enhance student learning.
